2023 FALL LITTLE STARS PROGRAM (8/6/23)

Welcome *Spotlight Dancers* to the 2023 Fall session of the Little Stars dance program. Our goal is to introduce dance to your child while promoting self-esteem and peer interaction.

What's New: Little Stars is a side by side class where Mommy, Daddy or a guardian may participate in the class to help with social distancing, shoe changing and escorting their little one to the restroom.

Class Session: The Fall Session is 13 classes over 4 months meeting once per week for 30 minutes.

Wednesday students	September 13th - December 13th
Friday students	September 15th - December 15th
Saturday students	September 16th - December 16th

Attire:

- Girls are required to wear leotards and tights, and pink leather ballet shoes (no satin ballet slippers), and tan tap shoes. As in prior years, no Target, Walmart or other tap shoes with aluminum taps may be worn in the studio as they will damage our floors.
- Dance shoes are not to be worn outside of studio (wood floors and carpet at home are ok). If your child's shoes have scratches, get scratches or have been worn outside, they will need to be replaced.
- Girls may wear a skirt over their leotard so long as they will not be distracted by it.
- Boys are required to wear a t-shirt and dance pants or sweat pants, black ballet shoes, and black tap shoes.
- Parents should wear something comfortable that is easy to move around in and socks or if they have them, dance shoes.
- Outside shoes may not be worn on the dance studio floor.

Scheduled Breaks & Special Weeks:

- September 25th - 30th Bring a friend to dance week
- October 24th - October 30th: Wear your costume to dance class
- November 21st No Little Stars Classes Held
- November 22nd - 25th: Studio closed for Fall Break
- December 11th - 16th: Small recital to be held in the classroom and last class for the Fall

Other Notes:

- Only registered students and their parent or guardian may enter the studio due to capacity limits.
- During the last scheduled class, we will hold mini-recital to demonstrate what the students have learned during the session.
